When the Brickell City Center in Miami, FL, is completed in April 2016 it will be comprised of three towers serving as home to a high-end hotel with multiple restaurants and retail shops, two 43-story condominium towers, an office complex and an upscale mall. The Brickell City Center represents a common type of construction project in dense urban areas. With limited space for footprints, developers are finding the space they need by building up.

Floor Technologies poured 195,000 square feet of underlayment, which helped to bring to level the floors, as well as aiding in the transitions between finished floor goods.
